The JSAS accepts submissions in the following languages: English, Armenian, French, Italian, and German.

Fonts and transliteration:

Please use 12 point Times or Times New Roman font.

Page format should be US letter (8.5 x 11 inches).

Punctuation should follow US standards: Punctuation placed with quotation marks; quotation marks instead of crochets.

All citations of foreign languages should include the original language.

For foreign scripts please use a Unicode font and attach it electronically with your submission.

For transliteration of names and words from Classical Armenian, please follow the Hübschmann-Meillet-Benveniste system of transliteration; for Modern Armenian please follow the modified LoC transliteration table found at the back of earlier volumes of JSAS. Transliteration of other languages should follow the conventions of the most recent ISO iteration.
